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ANTI-RAGGING MECHANISM OF THE INSTITUTION

CHAPTER I PRELIMINARY

1. Short Title and Commencement

- 1.1. These rules may be called **"The Anti-Ragging Statute of the Institution"**
- 1.2. They shall come into force with immediate effect upon approval by the competent Authority of the Institution.

2. Statutory Authority

- 2.1. These rules are framed **in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 26(1)(g)** of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, read with:
 - a) Regulation 3, Regulation 6, Regulation 7, and Regulation 9 of the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, and
 - b) the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *University of Kerala v. Council of Principals of Colleges* and allied matters.
 - 2.2. These rules shall also apply mutatis mutandis in conformity with the norms of the **Bar Council of India Legal Education Rules, 2020**, wherever applicable.
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CHAPTER II DEFINITIONS

3. Definitions In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:

- 3.1. "Ragging" shall have the same meaning as assigned under Regulation 2(e) of the UGC Regulations, 2009.
 - 3.2. "Institution" means the law college affiliated to the concerned University.
 - 3.3 "Anti-Ragging Committee" means the committee constituted under Rule 4 of this Statute.
 - 3.3. "Anti-Ragging Squad" means the squad constituted under Rule 5 of this Statute.
 - 3.4. "Competent Authority" means the Head of the Institution or any authority authorized by the Governing Body.
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CHAPTER III

CONSTITUTION OF ANTI-RAGGING MECHANISM

4. Anti-Ragging Committee

4.1. There shall be constituted an Anti-Ragging Committee in the Institution in accordance with Regulation 6(1) of the UGC Regulations, 2009.

The Committee shall consist of the following members, namely:

- a) Head of the Institution – **Chairperson**
- b) Senior faculty members of the Institution
- c) Representatives of civil or police administration, wherever indicated
- d) Representatives of the local community
- e) Parent representatives
- f) Student representatives (preferably senior students)
- g) Any other members as may be deemed appropriate by the Institution

4.2. The broad-based composition of the Committee shall ensure institutional, community, parental, and student participation, as mandated under Regulation 6(2).

5. Anti-Ragging Squad

5.1. There shall be constituted an **Anti-Ragging Squad**, which shall function as the **operational and monitoring arm** of the Anti-Ragging Committee, **in accordance with Regulation 6(3) of the UGC Regulations, 2009.**

5.2. The Squad shall consist of:

- a. Faculty members
- b. Administrative staff
- c. Senior students, wherever permitted

5.3. The Squad shall remain vigilant, mobile, and proactive, particularly during the initial academic period, which is recognized as the most vulnerable phase for incidents of ragging.



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CHAPTER IV

OBJECTIVES OF THE ANTI-RAGGING MECHANISM

6. Objectives

The Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad shall function with the following objectives, as contemplated under Regulation 3 of the UGC Regulations, 2009:

- 6.1. Prevention of Ragging to prevent the occurrence of ragging in any form, whether within or outside the campus.
- 6.2. Protection of Student Dignity and Safety to ensure a safe, secure, and dignified academic environment for all students, particularly freshers.
- 6.3. Zero-Tolerance Policy to enforce a strict policy of zero tolerance towards ragging and all acts incidental or ancillary thereto.
- 6.4. Regulatory and Judicial Compliance to implement and enforce directions issued by statutory authorities, regulatory bodies, and courts of law relating to prohibition of ragging.



CHAPTER V

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS

7. Monitoring and Vigilance

7.1. The Committee and Squad shall ensure continuous monitoring of:

- a. Hostels
- b. Classrooms
- c. Corridors and common areas
- d. Campus premises

7.2. Surprise inspections shall be conducted by the Anti-Ragging Squad, **as required under Regulation 7(1).**

8. Awareness and Sensitization

8.1. The Institution shall conduct regular awareness programmes for students.

8.2. Information shall be disseminated regarding:

- a. Meaning and scope of ragging
- b. Legal and disciplinary consequences
- c. Mechanisms for reporting complaints

9. Receipt of Complaints

9.1. The Anti-Ragging Committee shall receive complaints through appropriate channels.

9.2. Confidentiality of the complainant shall be ensured, and protection against victimization shall be provided, **as mandated under Regulation 7(3).**

10. Inquiry and Recommendations

10.1. The Committee shall conduct inquiries into allegations of ragging.

10.2. Upon conclusion of inquiry, the Committee shall recommend appropriate disciplinary action to the Competent Authority **in accordance with Regulation 9.**

11. Coordination with Authorities

11.1. The Institution may coordinate with law enforcement agencies wherever required.

11.2. Compliance with all statutory and regulatory mandates shall be ensured.



CHAPTER VI

MANDATORY COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

12. Anti-Ragging Undertaking

- 12.1. Every student shall submit an **anti-ragging affidavit / undertaking**, as required under **Regulation 4 of the UGC Regulations, 2009**.
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13. Display of Information

- 13.1. Anti-ragging warnings, helpline numbers, and contact details shall be prominently displayed on campus and on the institutional website.
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14. Institutional Accountability

- 14.1. The Institution shall be responsible for prevention of ragging and for taking prompt and effective action on complaints, **as provided under Regulation 7(2)**.
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15. Disciplinary Action

- 15.1. Students found guilty of ragging shall be liable for severe disciplinary action, including but not limited to suspension, expulsion, and reporting to statutory authorities, **in accordance with Regulation 9**.
